



Student Visas (Helpful Information for International Students)

Your education provider (Anglo Skills College) will give you a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies which you use to apply for your chosen student visa.

Deposit Required for Student Visa Letters (Requirement of all educational institutions):

- 6-month study period: £1,500
- 9-month study period: £2,000

Documents that are typically needed to obtain a student visa:

- Initial Acceptance letter to from your chosen college.
- Unconditional offer and student acceptance form from your chosen college (signed by student).
- Visa letter from your chosen college addressed to your British Embassy who will provide the visa.
- A receipt from your chosen college stating that you have paid the required deposit.

As per your Visa requirements, study of these course must be over a minimum of 6 months (Note. Higher level courses require a longer period of study in order to complete the needs of the qualification)

Documents we will need to assess your application and provide you with the essential documents needed for your chosen student visa.

- A copy of valid passport
- 1 passport size photograph
- Copy of qualifications
- Completed Enrolment Form
- A copy of your C.V.
- Financial Evidence (Bank Statements etc)

What money evidence will a student need? (maintenance fund)

You must show that you have enough money to cover your course fees and living costs whilst studying in the UK. The money that you will need for living costs will depend on the length of your course and where you will study it.

You must show that you have: £1,015 per month for living costs if you are studying outside London or anywhere else in the UK for the majority of your study (more than 50% of your study time).
